

2018 TEE SET CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES

- 1. It is mandatory that you be able to stand on the first tee box unassisted before playing your first shot of the day. Group Photo at 6.45am and a Shot gun start at 7AM off Blue tees for men and Red tees for ladies.
- 2. No lift clean and place is being played today except that <u>plugged balls</u> on the mown part of the fairways may be lifted cleaned and placed up to 20cm away but no nearer the hole. Play it as it lies for all other ball positions.
- 3. Local rules: (1) due to heavy maintenance and weed-spraying, there is bare earth under many of the trees. These are being played as Ground under repair as a local rule and you may lift and drop your ball no nearer the hole to take relief please note you are not to clean your ball whilst taking relief. (2) Some bunkers have been washed out recently and the matting is coming through. If you come to rest against the matting, you may take relief and drop your ball in the bunker on an area of the bunker not impacted by the matting. In both cases please ensure your marker confirms your taking of the relief.
- 4. It is a large group today so to speed up play we have requested the course mark a "gimme" circle on the greens. Only putts inside the circle are allowed to be picked up with the addition of 1 stroke to your score. Outside the circle, all putts must be putted.
- 5. Please swap score cards with your cart partner and write neatly. Ask you caddy for score verification but they are not to mark the cards. There are no mulligans allowed.
- 6. The event is individual stroke play using your most up to date and lowest club handicap. Must have an official Tee Set handicap and have competed 5 rounds with Tee Set in 2018 to win Low Nett overall.
- 7. Awards will be low net overall (Tee Set Champion for 2018), second and third low net. There is a low gross award, low putts, 1st Eagle, 1st Birdie, 1st Sandy and 1st Par >= 30 handicap. Please <u>mark the card clearly</u> with the number of holes played since you teed off to achieve the eagle, birdie, sandy or par and <u>not</u> the actual hole number.
- 8. There will be longest drive men and women on hole #9. JS Luwansa (1 week-end night stay with breakfast for 2) are kindly sponsoring nearest to the pin prizes on hole #8 and hole #15. The Hole-in-one prize on #4 is sponsored by Mayapada Hospital (Platinum Medical Check-up voucher) and the Hole-in-one prize on #12 is sponsored by Matoa National Golf Club (one year's membership).
- 9. Please play a provisional ball if the first ball is in danger of not being found. Avoid slow play.
- 10. Drinks and Smoothies will be provided around the course courtacy of Jack Calcote, San Miguel and funds from the Tee Set kitty. Wulan and Tuti will drive the drinks carts so be nice to the girls if you want them to return to your group more than once. The Hot Dog stand care of Hot Hed will be in operation.
- 11. Breakfast and lunch will be provided upstairs in the club's function rooms. Margaritas, selected spirits and beer are provided but please bring your own wine. Trophy presentation and lucky door prizes to be during and after lunch. Craig Ewers will provide a band for the afternoon's entertainment and Billy Lloyd a bit of his traditional reggae.
- 12. The most import rule for the day is have fun and please join us in thanking our sponsors for making this event happen.
