## HOUSE KEEPING:

### Overall

All administration for weekly games will now be managed via the Mygolf2U app which has been trialled during 2021. Weekly game sign-ups, handicaps and results will all be posted there along with the details of each week's events – time, tee boxes, format for scoring, price, course etc...

With many of the societies already using the same app, most of you will be familiar with how to use it but please do not hesitate to ask if there are any queries.

### Handicaps

In order to have as many scores consolidated into one place, we will be managing handicaps on the mygolf2u app as well. Anyone with an incomplete record will be assigned a zero handicap until such time as their record is up to date – players are responsible for ensuring any games in the old Northern Systems database not already in mygolf2u and which are required to complete the 20 scores for a full handicap are entered into the app. Please see me if there are any questions regarding this. The Northern Systems program will no longer be maintained by Tee Set when it's license runs out at the end of this year and so anyone wishing to keep their past scores for prosperity should make suitable arrangements.

JAWS, D.O.G.S. and Tee Set official events will have the scores automatically uploaded for you but any other rounds should be entered yourself as we cannot access your record to do it remotely.

### Weekly Game Scoring

1. Score Cards must be submitted to Admin as soon as you come off the last hole (*before showering*). It must be clear with numbers 1 to 9 and not over and under +1, 0, -1 etc .
2. Score must be entered into mygolf2u before submitting card to Admin for verification. (*it's not Admin job to enter your score. If you need help ask one of the other players as most already know how to do this.*)

3. Admin will check mygolf2u score against the card to ensure correct data because this directly impacts the Leader Board.
- 4. The Leader Board will determine the tournament winners.**
5. If you fail to submit in time for announcements you forfeit your chance for a prize. *(about 20 minutes after the last group returns to the Club House.)*

## Non-scoring prizes:

We wish to continue to recognize some of the traditional Tee Set non-scoring prizes. These will be clearly shown in the mygolf App for each tournament. *Please make sure you provide this information to Admin when submitting your card.*

1. First eagle
2. First birdie
3. First par HC > 30
4. First sandy
5. Skirt (not past the Ladies tee box)
6. Others as may be scheduled on the day.

## Profiles:

To enable us to be better able to reach you in the event of changes in schedule or arrangements and/or for other administrative matters, its important your mygolf2u profile is up to date – can you please check and complete this asap. *Your profile page is located next to your photo on the app home page. Email and phone numbers particularly are required, please.*

## Tee Set Local Rules:

These “local rules” are specific to Tee Set and most likely will not apply to other competitions especially when Tee Set is joining other societies – rules for these weeks will be announced by the organizers of the respective events. *They may change from time to time so please pay attention to future announcements.*

They are made to make your game ENJOYABLE as weekend golfers. The two most controversial are related to “prefered lies” and “foot prints in sand traps”. Reasoning for such rules are;

**Sand trap.** Coming to rest in a foot print. Why should you be penilised for poor etiquette of others, and may cost you a competition.

*Therefore: Mark, lift, rake and replace by placing the ball on the original spot*

**Preferred lies.** A small percentage of players do it anyway, so who is going to call them out. So give every player the same conditions.

*Therefore: preferred lie on fairways and first cut and always out of a divot.*

*As previously announced, winter rules are in effect at all Tee Set events between 1<sup>st</sup> October and 31<sup>st</sup> March – the rainy season. On the fairway and first cut, you may mark, lift, clean and place your ball no nearer the hole and within 1 scorecard of the original spot.*

## **SOP Standard Operating Procedures and Constitution**

In order to have a standardized set of procedures for Tee Set, we will formalize these into an SOP. This will be drafted in the next few weeks for review and adoption by Tee Set.

## **Other**

There are more topics but this is long enough for now. I trust that these occasional Newsletters help to make our games with Tee Set more enjoyable.
